In previous years we have had a range of large scale lanterns, from a giant Eagle representing Barclays Bank, to large scale Police lantern made by local officers, to a giant slipper promoting the annual Pantomime shows at the New Victoria Theatre.



Date: Tuesday 16 November 2010
Time: The workshop will start at 9.00am and we will aim to finish by 4pm. We suggest you bring a packed lunch with you as it will be a full days work!



Venue: Bishop David Brown School, Albert Drive, Woking, GU21 5RF
Other information: We suggest you have a team of 2 or 3 people to make your masterpiece and wear casual clothes.

The workshop will be led by a professional artists who will guide you through the process of making your large scale lantern along with tips and advice about decorating to make it truly unique!

You can be as ambitious as you like with your design - but please ensure you are able to take it away at the end of the workshop (i.e. it will fit in your car!!)

Please note that by attending the workshop, you are committing to attending and carrying your lantern in the Diwali parade on Friday 19 November in Woking Park. On this day, you will need to meet in the Leisure Centre at 5.15pm for a short safety briefing and lighting of your lantern for the commencement of the parade at 6pm.
